WELCOME TO OUR NEW EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Since the sudden passing of co-founder Jim Guerrucci in March 2015, **The Social and Learning Institute** had been operating under the leadership of the Board of Trustees and its president, Sheridan Bell. At the annual meeting held in October 2015, Debbie Sellers was selected as the new Executive Director. When speaking of her new position she stated, “It is a privilege to carry forward the legacy of care and commitment established by Jim Guerrucci. I am excited to work with the teaching staff in expanding the SLI program, continually seeking opportunities to enrich the lives of our students, and pursuing additional avenues of funding for the Institute.”

Debbie originally began her service to SLI in June 2012 as a member of the Board of Trustees. She now returns to SLI while continuing to serve as a part-time program officer for Unity Foundation of La Porte County. Prior to her non-profit experience at Unity, Debbie worked for nearly a decade in private school administration. She holds a Masters in Public Administration from Indiana University and brings experience in fiscal management and organizational leadership.

WE ARE THANKFUL FOR ... A NEW ROOF!

No more drips! No more buckets! The roof of **The Social and Learning Institute** has been replaced! In January 2014 the area where the new addition and old roof connected began to leak. Over the next year the aged portion of the roof deteriorated much faster than anticipated. During last year’s winter season the roof had over 15 different location leaks that required temporary patching. The recent harsh winters had taken their toll and the Board of Trustees realized the critical and urgent need to replace the flat roof on the original building. SLI was fortunate to receive grant funding from the Barker Welfare Foundation to establish **The Social and Learning Institute**

Roof Fund. Once work began, it was quickly determined that the damage to the flat roof and underlying surfaces was even worse than expected. With additional contributions from NIPSCO, generous individuals, and a line of credit extended by Horizon Bank, SLI was able to move forward with the roof replacement. SLI is grateful to AA Rain-Tite Roofing for their dedicated effort in completing this project before the beginning of the current school year. Donations to the Roof Fund continue to be accepted. SUPPORTING OUR MISSION

Music + Yoga + Technology = Enrichment!

Unity Foundation of La Porte County's Power for Good grant funding has been instrumental in expanding the enrichment opportunities offered to SLI students. In 2014 Unity awarded \$1,800 to begin a music education and therapy program. Not only are the students enjoying this activity together, they are enhancing their communication development skills (i.e., word usage, articulation, speech rhythm, and social communication). Dennis Brittain now leads music classes every other Tuesday.

This year, Unity awarded \$900 to allow for the continuation of a pilot therapeutic yoga program introduced in 2014. On alternating Tuesdays, Marsha Wenig, the founder of Yoga Kids International,

engages SLI students in physical and mental therapy developed to instill self-confidence in balance, movement, and eye/hand coordination. Students enjoy learning the movements and breathing exercises known to alleviate stress and anxiety.

An additional \$525 was awarded to purchase special needs educational software. The different levels of software selected can meet and challenge the educational needs of SLI's low, mid, and high functioning students. SLI has been fortunate to receive several gently used, yet still technologically relevant, computers for student use. Using these machines, the teaching staff now has the ability to guide select students into learning areas that cannot be approached in a group.
